Since 2019 CCI is statutorily incorporated under an Act of Parliament as the apex representative body of all stakeholders in the construction sector.

The growing conviction that the capacity of the Construction Industry which has great potential to stimulate economic growth, is not properly harnessed largely contributed to the formation of CCI as the apex representative body of construction industry.

The Chamber as a statutorily incorporated body cannot declare profits or dividends to the members. The Chamber is administered by a Board of Management and a Council elected by the Members along with the Secretary General / CEO. All the stakeholders of the construction industry are very well represented in the Council, which is the main policy making body.

CCI is now positioned as the "Main Voice" on issues affecting the Construction Industry and is committed to protecting and promoting the construction industry. We endeavor to mediate wherever necessary on issues faced by our members. It also acts as a facilitator of investments on construction related development projects.

The Chamber enjoys a consultative status with the Government, Multilateral Development Banks and International Funding Agencies among many others.
