Recruitment of Nepali Construction Workers for Projects in Sri Lanka

To overcome the shortage of construction workers faced by our companies, on representations made by the CCI, the Hon. Prime Minister has approved the recruitment of 2500 workers from Nepal or Myanmar. This recruitment is to be undertaken through CCI and is open to the companies who are members of CCI. It is a requirement that CCI should monitor this recruitment and the departure of workers on completion of contracts. The terms and conditions of employment are given below.

Terms & Conditions of Employment

Monthly Salary Skilled workers US\$ 300.00 a. Helper US\$ 225.00

- In addition Food or Food Allowance of Rs. 15,000.00 to be provided. b.
- Free Accommodation to be provided c.
- Normal working hours d. Overtime to be paid for work after 8hrs

Employment Contract 2 years e.

- f. Paid Home Leave 30 days per year at end of contract Air Ticket To be provided both ways between g.
- Kathmandu and Colombo. One way ticket is

Rs. 40,000/= including taxes currently. However, CCI is negotiating for a better fare on group travel

8 hrs for 06 days/week (48hrs/week)

2. To facilitate the recruitment process the CCI has entered into a Service Agreement with a Nepalese Employment Agent, who is recommended by our Embassy in Nepal. The CCI will act as the facilitator and coordinator of the recruitment.

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- 3. The detailed procedure on recruitment and the Forms applicable can be down loaded form our website www.ccisrilanka.org. If you are interested in recruiting these workers as the step 1 you are kindly requested to send a duly completed clear copy of "Request for Foreign Construction Workers" to the undersigned.
- 4. Please note that as per the Nepali Labour Law the minimum period of employment contract for overseas work has to be 2 years. There is no restriction to engage these workers on another project once the initial project is completed.
- 5. The Chamber will maintain a comprehensive data base of the Nepalese workers recruited, including the details of passport, residence visa, employer, arrival date and due departure date for better coordination. Also, all these workers will be provided with a mobile telephone SIM card.
- 6. Nepalese Agent will charge a service fee of US\$ 300.00 per worker recruited. On completion of the selection and all statutory formalities this service fee will be payable to the Nepalese Agent through the Chamber. The Chamber will charge a facilitation fee of Rs10,000/= plus taxes per worker and reimbursement of other costs.
- 7. A computation on the cost of engaging workers from Nepal is give below.
